88 Viña Tabali Chardonnay Limari Valley Reserva Especial 2011 \$17 Medium- to full-bodied, balancing crunchy apple, Key lime and crisp pineapple notes with undertones of vanilla and cream. Drink now. 3,000 cases made.—N.W.

88 Viñedos Terranoble Cabernet Sauvignon Colchagua Valley Gran Reserva 2010 \$20 This rich red leads with spicy cherry reduction, licorice and grilled herb notes that follow through on the tobacco-tinged finish. Drink now. 10,000 cases made.—N.W.

87 Valle Secreto Cabernet Sauvignon Cachapoal Valley First Edition 2010 \$18 This red offers a solid core of ripe plum and black cherry notes offset with medium tannins, fresh acidity and a tangy finish. Drink now. 1,500 cases made.—N.W.

86 Vistamar Pinot Noir Casablanca Valley Sepia Reserva 2011 \$12 A forward, crisp style, blending cherry, red currant, game and light herbaceous undertones. Drink now. 10,000 cases made.—N.W.

Drink now through 2018. 100 cases imported.—A.N.

90 Louis Jadot Moulin-à-Vent Château des Jacques Clos du Grand Carquelin 2010 \$36 A subtle version, with hints of damson plum, sweet smoke, black currant, tobacco and anise, all backed by well-meshed acidity and fine tannins. Drink now through 2018.—A.N.

90 Domaine Labruyère Moulin-à-Vent Le Clos 2010 \$60 Fresh and well-focused, with bright blackberry, strawberry and pomegranate fruit complemented by nuanced notes of ground anise, fragrant tobacco and chocolate shavings. Features a fine-grained, graphite-accented finish. Drink now through 2020. 27 cases imported.—A.N.

89 Jean-Claude Debeaune Morgon Domaine de la Chaponne 2009 \$20 Well-layered and balanced, this creamy version offers a tarry base note meshed with crushed black cherry, blackberry coulis, licorice and chocolate nuances, with a refined finish. Drink now through 2019.—A.N.
